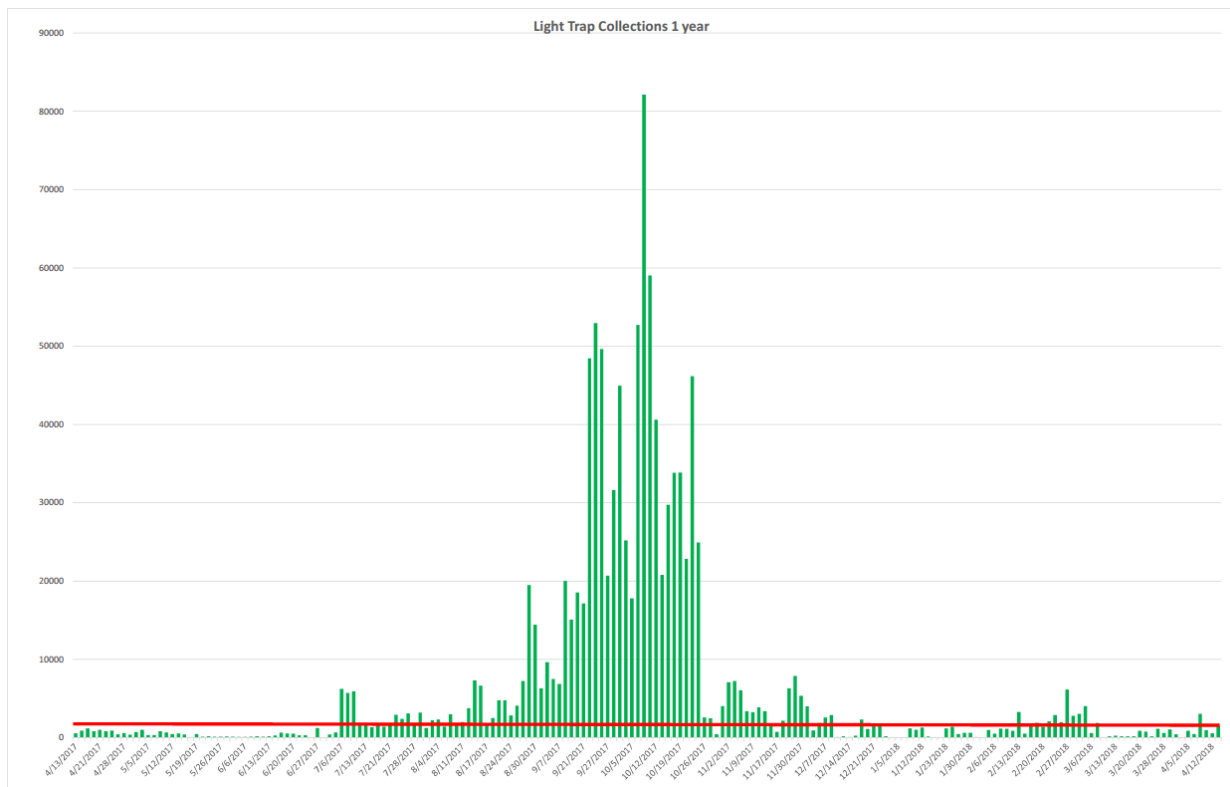


Week of 4/9/2018 Operations Update

A significant amount of rainfall was recorded in the early part of the week with some areas receiving over 4" of rain. We expect to see significant increase in the mosquito population towards the late part of next week as the larvae that develop in flooded areas both inland and in the salt marsh areas will be slow to mature due to low overnight temperatures.

The redline on the population chart below is the count as of Friday 13. The intention is to illustrate that mosquito abundance is weather dependent and not solely based on time of year as we had more mosquitoes in February but less in June of last year than currently.



We have had the trucks out every month over the winter as things would temporarily warm-up we would have justification to treat. This happened again Thursday into Friday and areas indicated in blue were treated Friday night.
