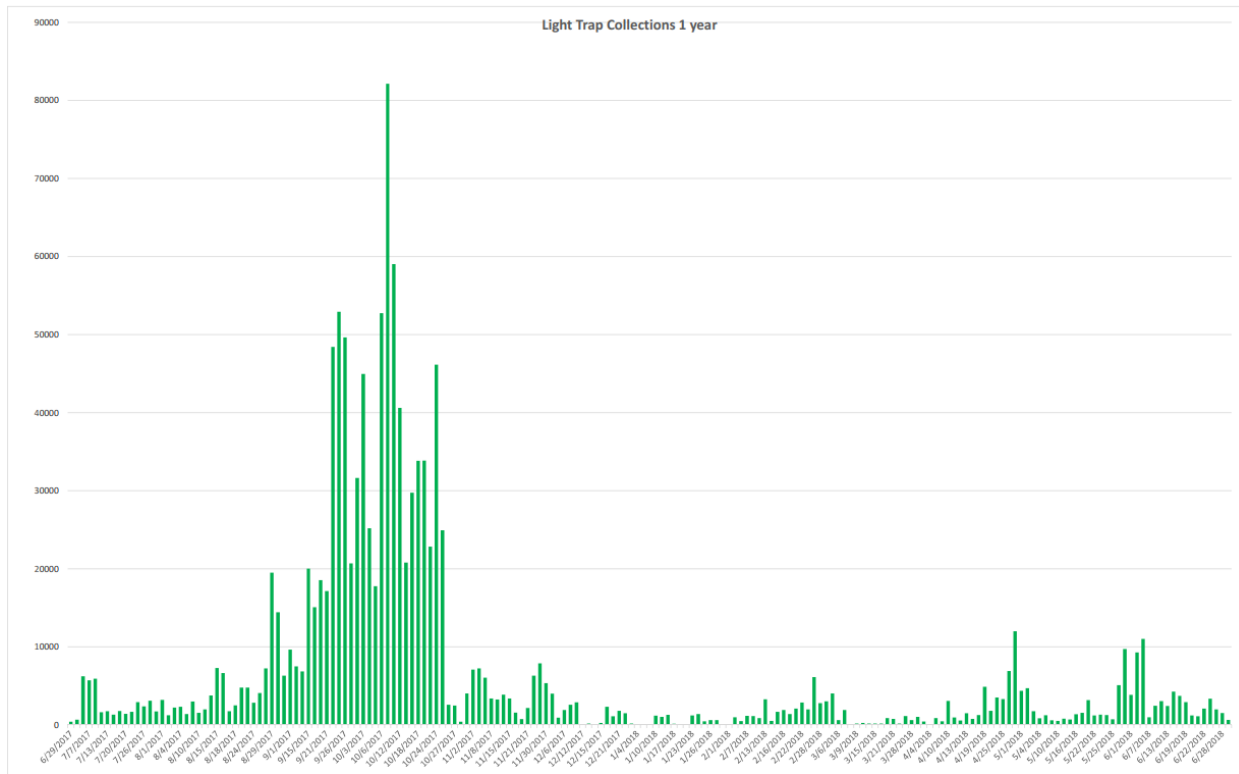


Week of 7/2/2018 Operations Update

Traps were set Sunday ahead of Fourth of July festivities. Of importance to this year's events were *Ae. Infirmatus* around the Riddle trap and elevated population of *Anopheles spp.* at Town Center. This necessitated a limited aerial adulticide mission with limited scope.



From the last update:

“Last significant rainfall was June 22. That would put a fresh batch of floodwater mosquitoes as early as July 2 so we will conduct surveillance on Sunday July 1 to assess the need for adulticide missions before Fourth of July festivities.”

Yellow zones were treated by truck in the AM by truck. Orange block is an aerial adulticide mission.
