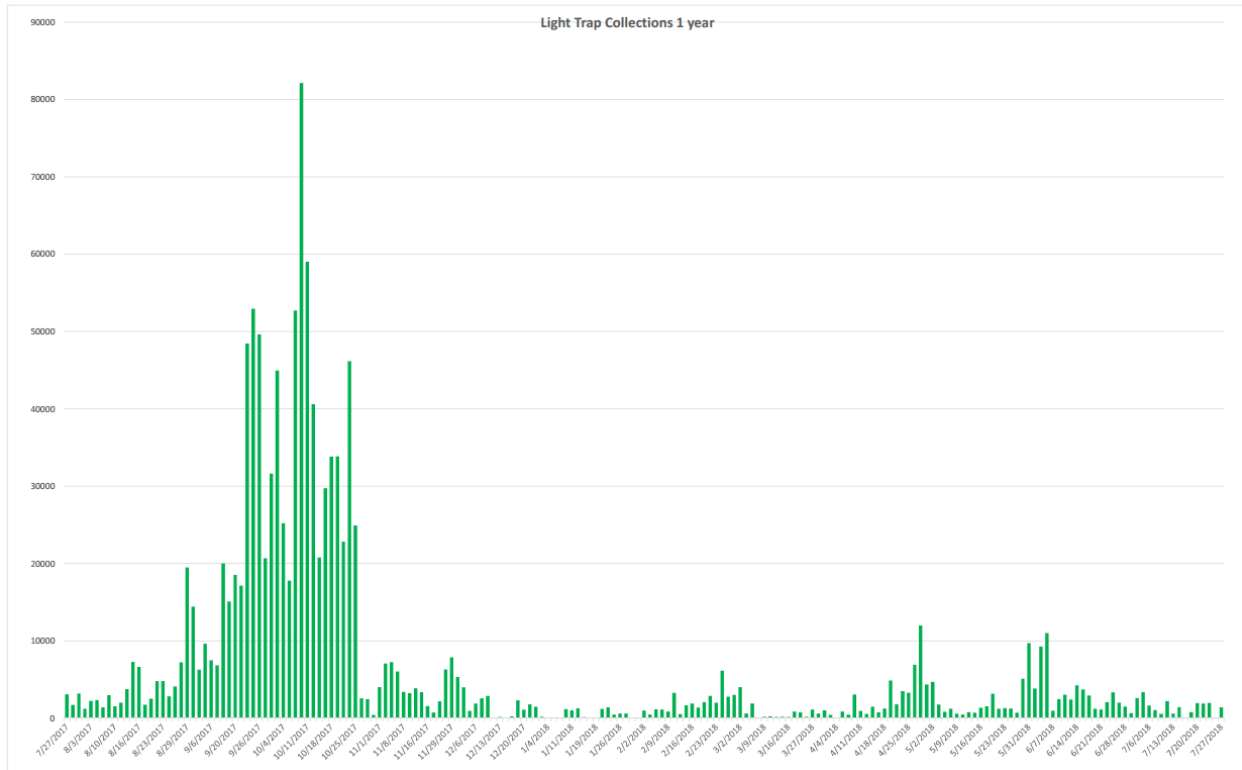


Week of 7/23/2018 Operations Update

The trend of low total population persists.



Last week I mentioned the following, “A dry down would be necessary to open up soil for flood-water mosquitoes to lay eggs, but consistent rain has prevented that from occurring.” Treatments for adult mosquitoes have focused around salt marsh areas in the north and south parts of the District. These are the only areas where drying down and wetting are occurring to produce mosquitoes.

Yellow zones were treated once, and orange were treated twice for the week in the AM by truck.
