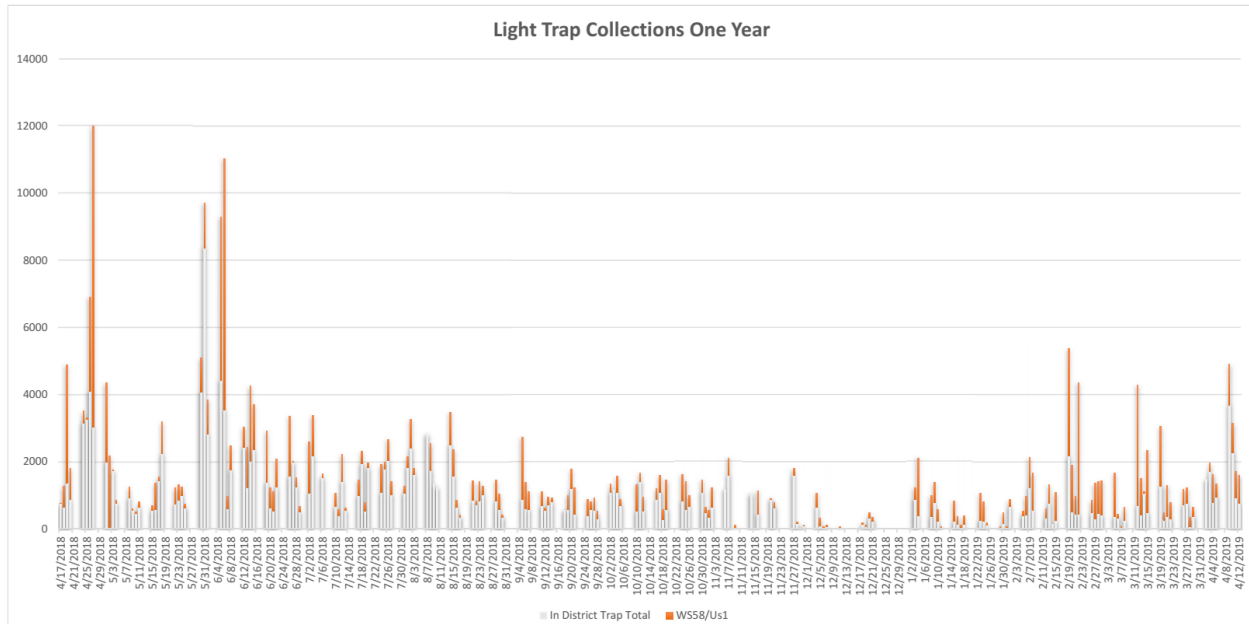


Week of 4/8/2019 Operations Update

The majority of the mosquito population inside the District this week consisted of *Culex nigirpalpus* in the vicinity of Matanzas Woods. *Coquilletidia peturbans* remained at a much lower level than the previous week affecting primarily Quail Hollow, Seminole Woods and Town Center. The stacked-bar graph below shows the total mosquitoes from all traps in the District in white. The red is the sole trap we keep on the West-side of US-1 to monitor outside the District.



Zones in yellow were sprayed by truck. Blocks in blue were treated by air.
