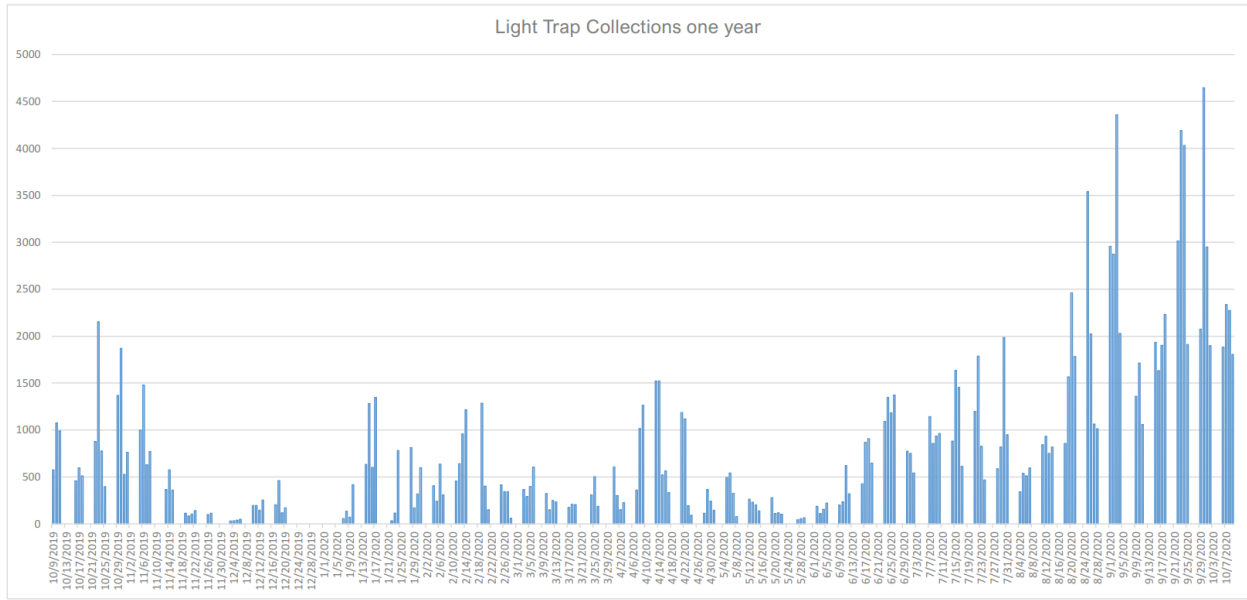
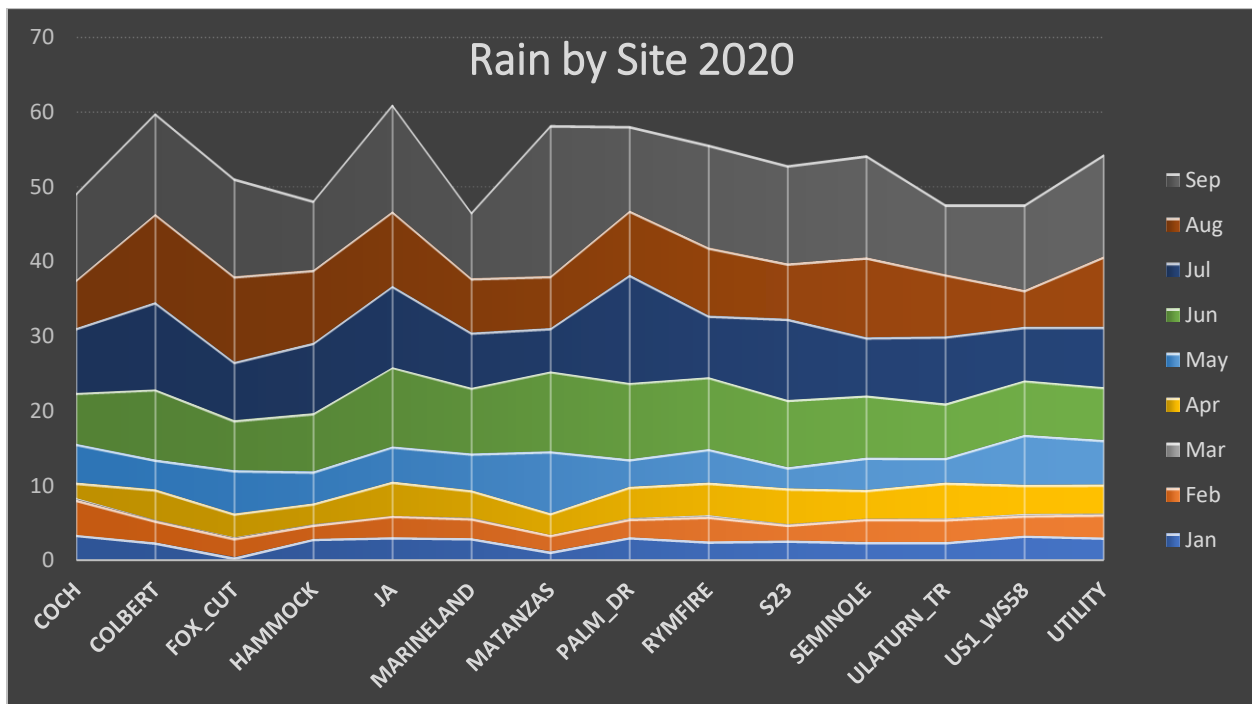


Week of 10/05/2020 Operations Update

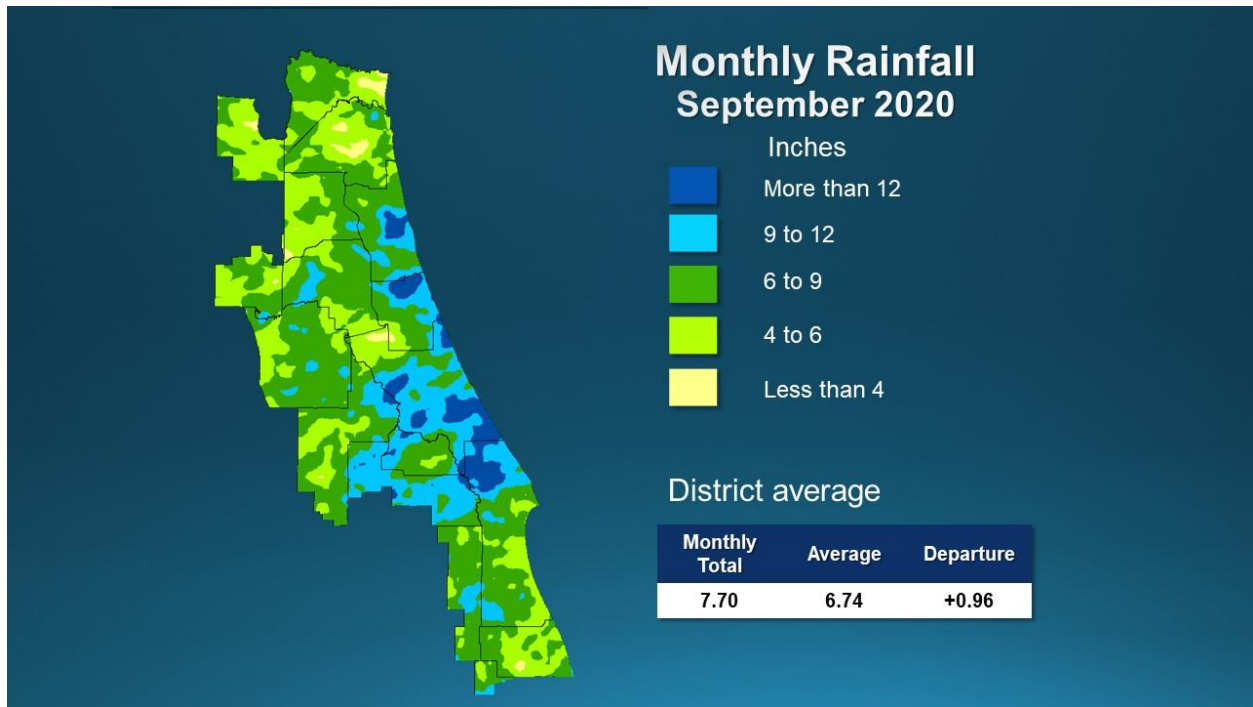
Culex nigripalpus continues to be the bulk of the mosquito population as rain amounts were very high in September. The bar graph below shows the total adult mosquitoes from all traps in the District for the past year (TTM).



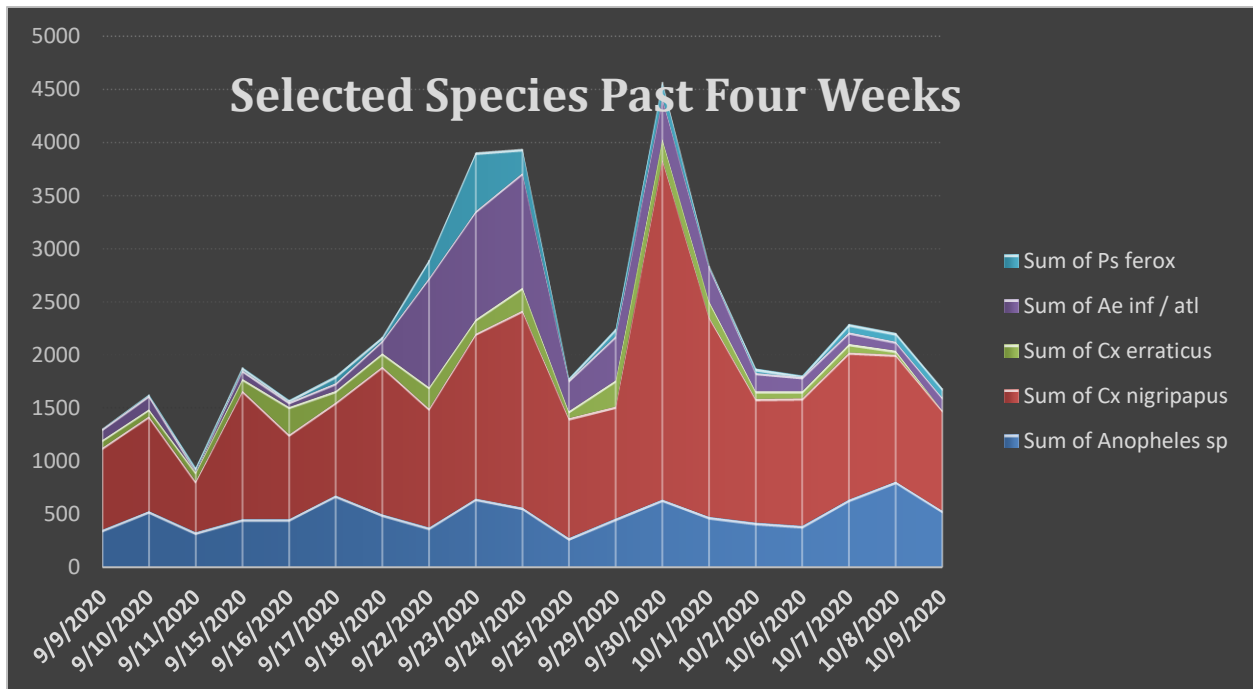
Rain by site and month in chart below.



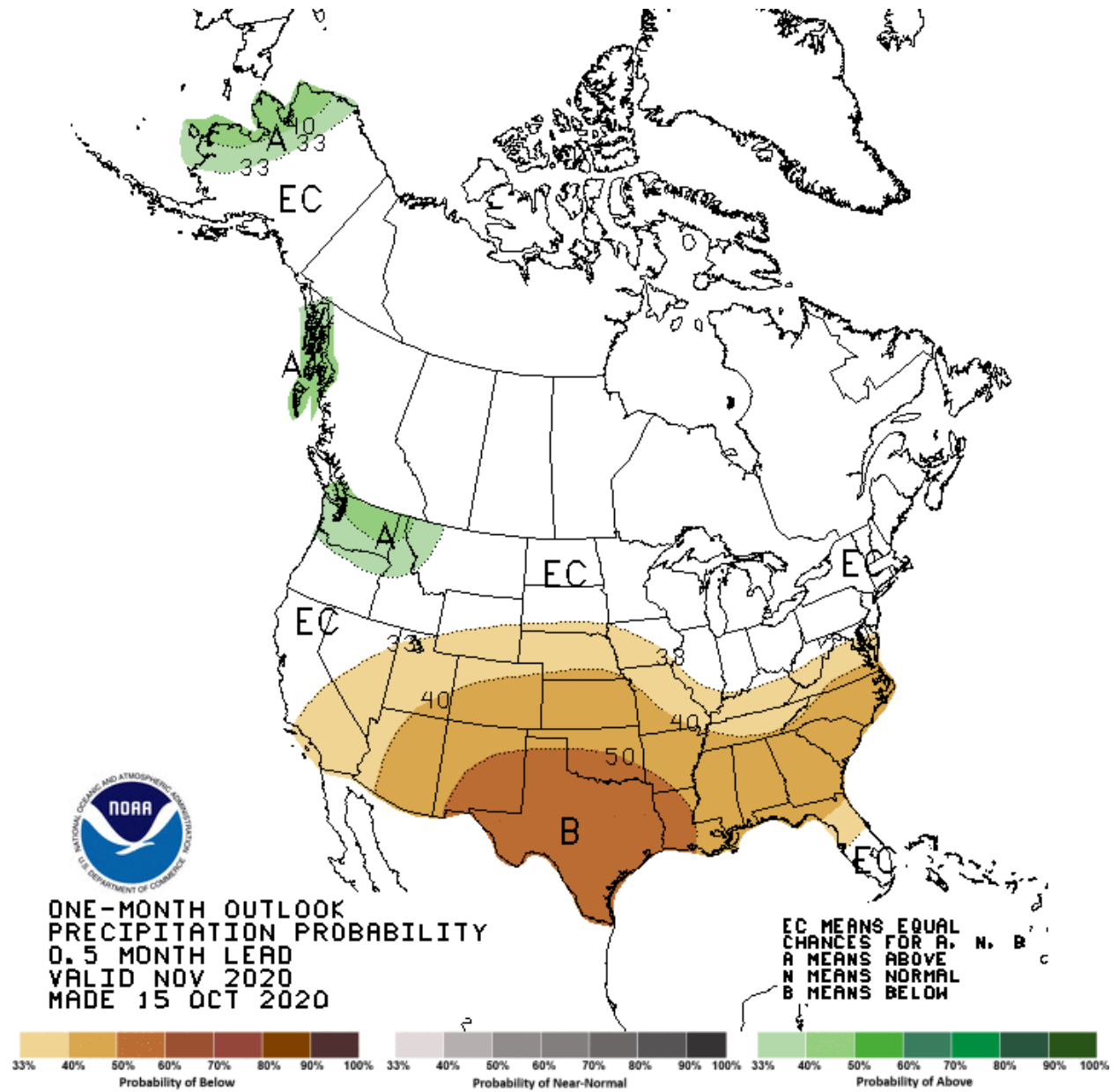
SJRWMD Monthly rainfall totals chart below.



Rain fall amounts have kept many areas flooded and enabled permanent water species of mosquitoes to proliferate for most of the past month. *Culex nigripalpus* is the majority of the trap totals for the past four weeks (Chart below).



The NWS predicts November will have a 33% chance of being dryer than average (chart below).
