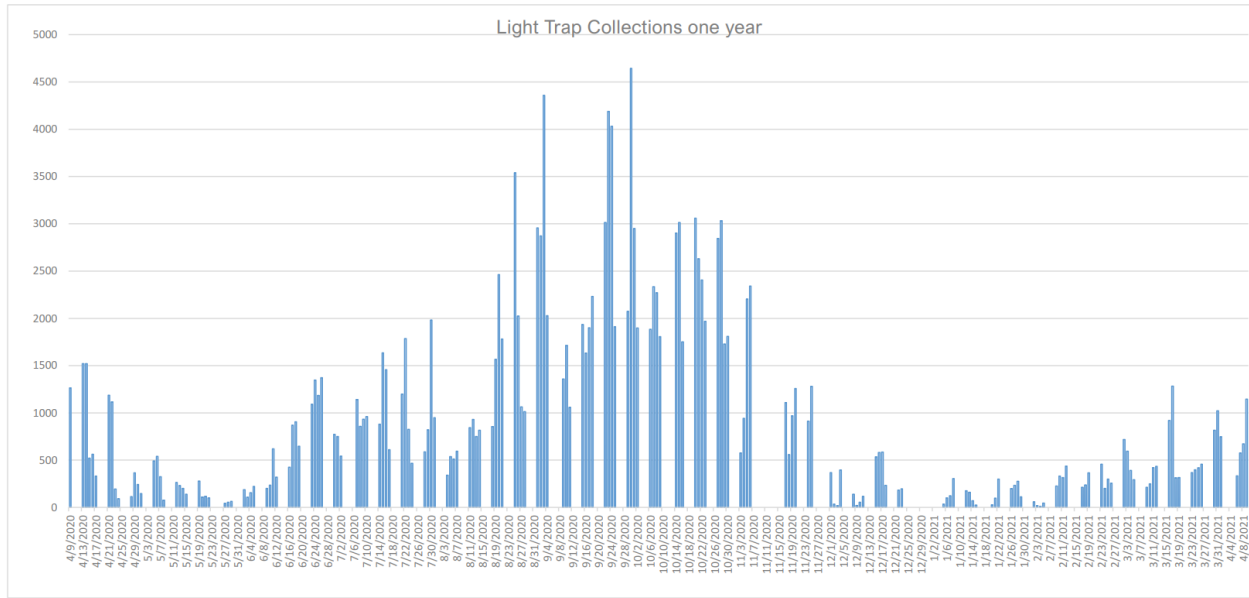
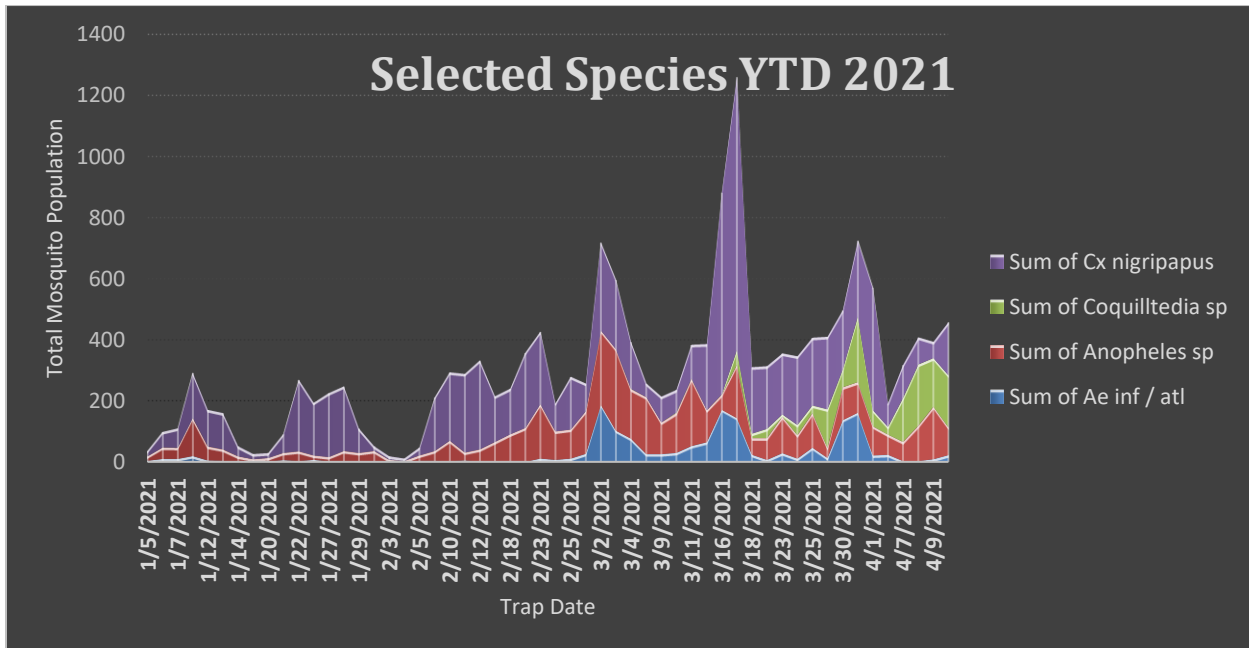


Week of 4/5/2021 Operations Update

The population of mosquitoes increased as the week progressed compared to last week due to an increase in *Culex nigripalpus*. The bar graph below shows the total adult mosquitoes from all traps in the District for the past year (TTM).

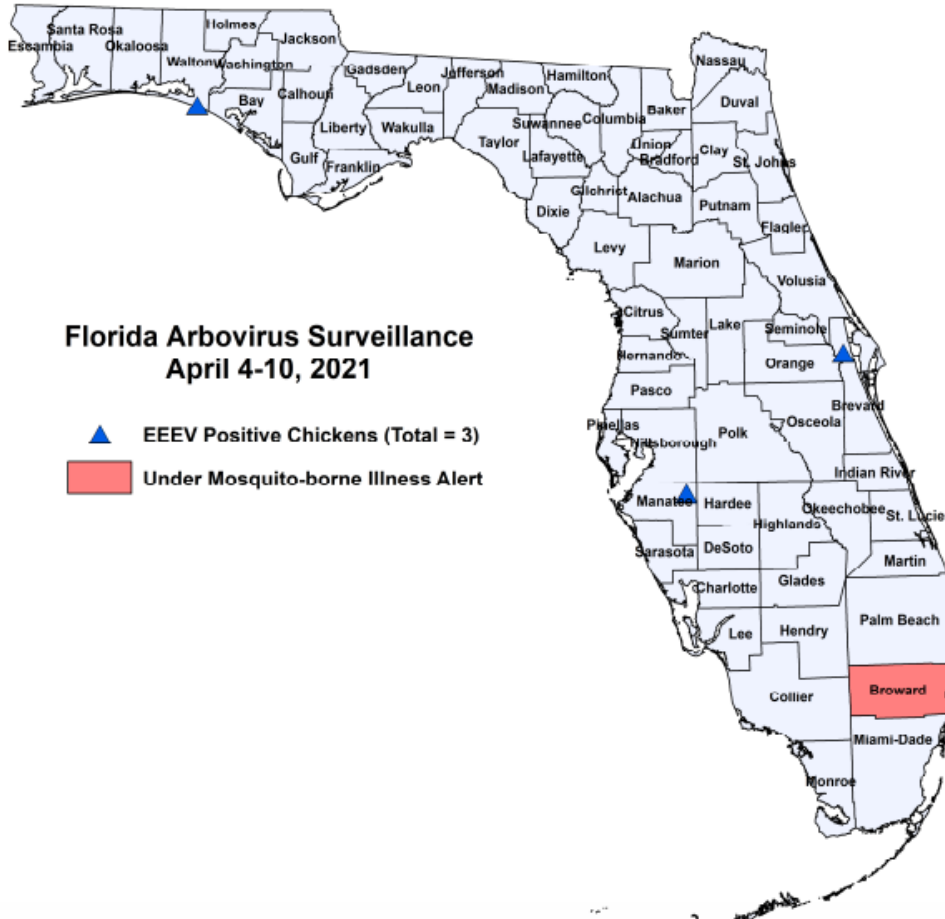


A relative decrease in *Anopheles spp.* and an increase in *Culex nigripalpus* week over week. Both are permanent water species with a short 1-mile flight range.
