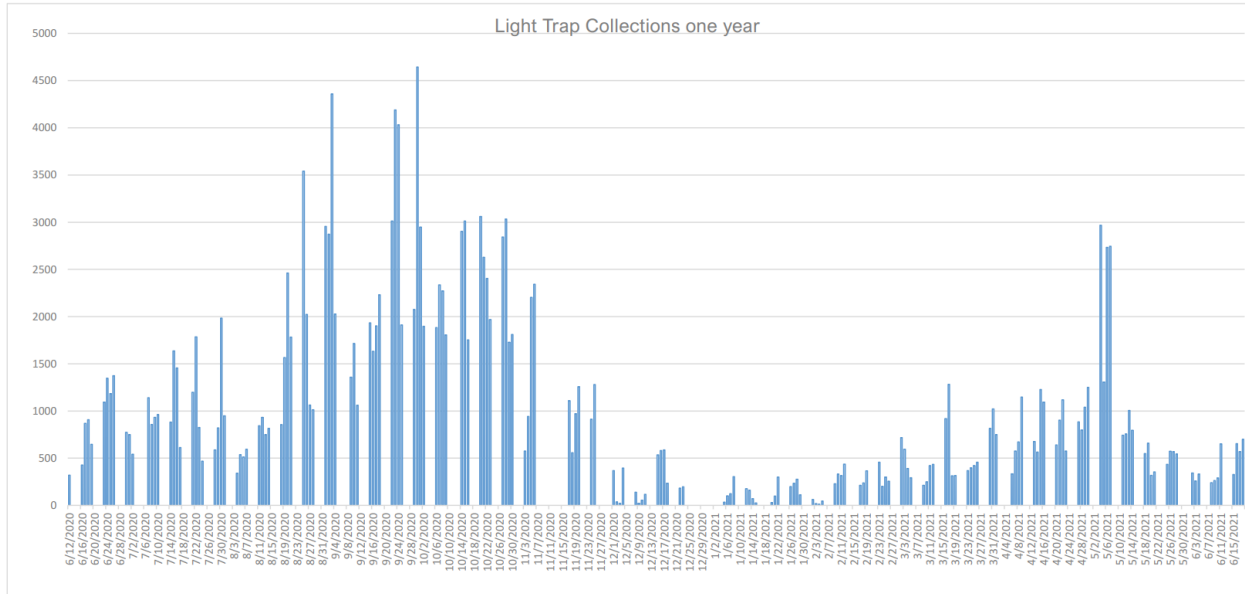
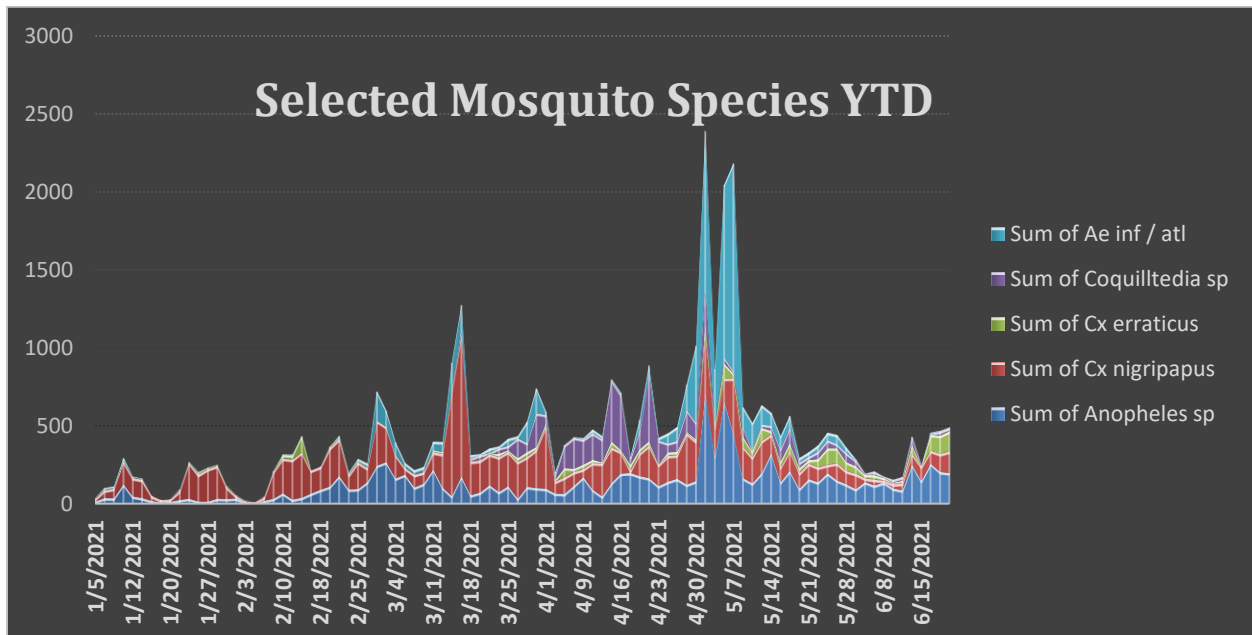


Week of 6/14/2021 Operations Update

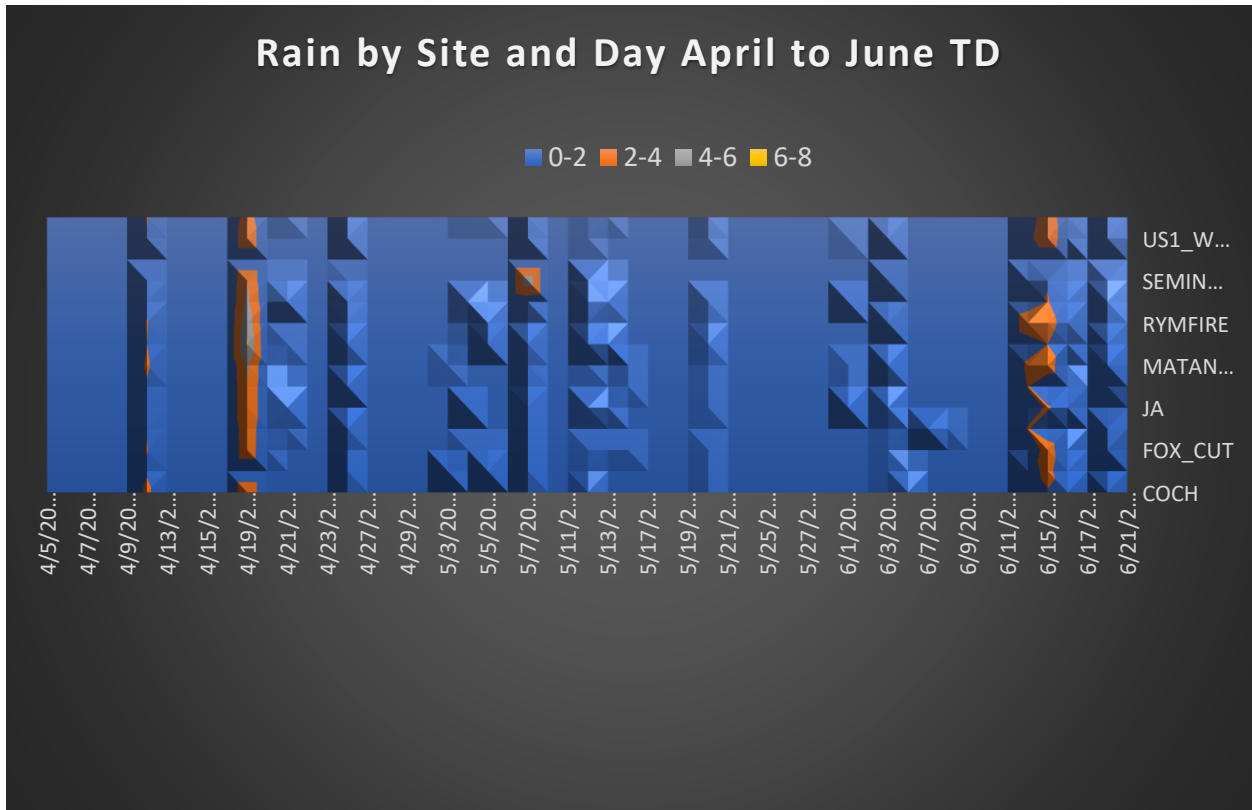
Fifth week of very low mosquito counts. Fourth week with no spraying. The bar graph below shows the total adult mosquitoes from all traps in the District for the past year (TTM).



The graph below shows the population of the most abundant mosquito species. The population of *Aedes infirmatus* increased rapidly beginning 4/30 almost two weeks after the last major rain event of 5" on 4/17- 4/18, and then precipitously dropped after aerial adulticide treatments the week of 5/3. Starting on 6/11 *Anopheles spp.* increased and stayed steady.



Mid-April was the last major rain event until the weekend of 6/12-13. We anticipate seeing an increase in the population of mosquitoes 7 – 10 days post rain event.
